

The Presidents Desk by Janet Wright

Some of us, willingly and often eagerly, embrace change. Some of us don't like change at all – we don't even want to move the furniture or go to a different grocery store.

For all of us, even those who welcome change, transitions can be hard!

They force us from the familiar and into the unknown.

So, how are we as a church family going to survive the upcoming challenges of change of the RGHT project?

Every transition has a time of ending, a time of chaos and a time of new beginnings. All three stages are challenging in and of themselves. Knowing that major changes bring chaos can prepare us to watch for it and "ride it out".

Ready or not, we, the North Bay Lutheran Church family, are headed for a major transition as we proceed with the RGHT project. Following are some thoughts on how we might do it with grace.

- 1. ACCEPT that transition is inevitable. It's going happen whether we want it too or not so let's makes the best of it.
- 2. EMBRACE the risk. Risk is an inevitable part of the transition process. See this time as an opportunity to display our faith. See it as God's way of surprising us with something better.
- 3. EXPECT negative consequences; they are going to happen. Don't let this catch us off guard. It is human nature to be critical when we don't have all the facts. Read the North Bay Compass newsletters, the Sunday bulletins, Facebook and "Have You Heard the Buzz?"

Keeping up on what is happening can ease uncertainty. Expect some anxiety and confusion to try to sneak in. This is all a necessary part of the process. Without these things there would be no victory.

- 4. MOVE forward in spite of it all. There's only one way to go survive change and that's to go through it! Never stop. Never give in. Keep going.
- 5. LOVE one another in all things.
- 6. REMEMBER we are not alone.

Joshua 1:9 "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."

Together we acknowledge that we are going through transition, so let's shout it out with enthusiasm and with excitement.




Worship by Pastor Brian


