RGHT project update: By the time you read this the lower level floor for the entire addition will have been poured allowing the construction workers to begin creating walls.

The trusses arrived late last week and the plan is to build the new roof in sections. The addition will get a roof first and then the existing building will get a "new hat". The work will be done on weekends due to the limited availability of the "boom" – I think that's the piece of equipment that lifts the trusses. Can you believe it? It is already June!!

At the end of this month we will be two years into our Capital Campaign to remodel our church. As of June 1, 2020, of the \$587,982.00 pledged, we have collected \$441,094 (approximately 75%). That leaves a balance of \$146,888 (approximately 25%) to be collected this final year.

If you come up with a suggested activity, let us know and we will include it next edition.



From the Secretary's Table

CREAMY LEMON PIE

15oz can evaporated milk

1 3.4oz box of instant lemon pudding mix

2 8oz packages cream cheese

3/4 C lemonade concentrate

For crust:

2 2/3 C Graham cracker crumbs

1/3 C sugar

2/3 C butter, melted

OR A READY MADE 9" Graham cracker crust

To make the crust:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees

Mix all ingredients and press into 9" PIE plate. Bake 10-12 minutes.

Filling:

In a small bowl mix milk and pudding with electric mixer on low for 2 minutes. Mixture will be thick.

In a medium bowl, beat cream cheeses until light and fluffy, about 3 minutes. Gradually add in lemonade concentrate. Gradually add pudding mix. Pour mixture into cooled crust or pre-made. Cover and refrigerate for at least 4 hours.
